Christian Healing. Nigel is also a Priest Associate at Galilee Episcopal Church in Virginia Beach, VA. He has been involved in the Healing Ministry for over 25 years. Fr. Nigel has a heart and passion to help veterans suffering from PTS. As a Royal Marine Commando and drill instructor, he can relate to these men and women who suffer in silence.

Nigel was born and educated in England. He served for six and a half years in Her Majesty's Royal Marine Commandos. His last two years as a Marine were spent as a **drill instructor**.

Nigel has been involved in the Healing Ministry for over 24 years. He was director of the healing ministry for the Episcopal Diocese of Albany, NY, at Christ the King Spiritual Life Center in Greenwich NY from 2004-2013.

***His conviction to pray for healing came in 1989*** when his sister, Julie Sheldon, a ballet dancer with the Royal Ballet in London, was healed by God through the late Canon Jim Glennon. It was a dramatic healing from a neurological condition called Dystonia, a disease that left her curled up in a fetal position and close to death. **Being a professional effect healing life had a**

By 2008, Nigel began the **Welcome Home Initiative (WHI)** a program of healing for veterans. This program invites men & women of our Armed Forces (from all wars), who have served in combat, to come "free of charge" and be "welcomed home."

In October 2009, *Nigel was hospitalized for over 3 months with H1N1. He was placed on a ventilator, and put in a chemically induced coma. Suffering from pneumonia and secondary pneumonia, he was near death. His pulmonologist told him; "you were as close to death without dying as I have ever seen."* Nigel continues to give thanks and praise to all the intercessors who lifted him up in prayer. He is **alive** because of prayer. **Praise God!**

Nigel and his wife Lynn live in Virginia Beach, VA.
